Corporate Partnership Events

Meetings

Meetings are how HKN members stay up to date with the organization. Due to the required attendance of our meetings, corporate partners typically will be able to connect with about 30-60 members. Usually corporate partners present networking events or tech talks at our meetings. After the officers conduct organization business, partners will have an opportunity to give a 20-30 minute presentation, answer student questions, and meet with students individually during and after dinner.
